### Revisit and review

Review all sounds by one of these methods.

### Teach

Phase Four is about Consonant blends (also called consonant clusters) are a collection of two or three different consonant sounds that are each heard when the word is pronounced. For example, let's look at the word "drink." Both the letters "d" and "r" are consonants. Children entering Phase Four will be able to represent each of 42 phonemes by a Grapheme, and be able to blend phonemes to read CVC words and segment CVC words for spelling. They will have some experience in reading simple two-syllable words and captions. They will know letter names and be able to read and spell some tricky words.

spelling the tricky words *he, she, we, me, be, was, you, they, all, are, my her*

Practise reading words with consonant clusters in them
