Reading

Your child will then progress onto reading early phonics books and you will receive more information about this letter in the term.

Tapestry

Your child's learning will be recorded through the use of Tapestry. If your child had a Tapestry account at their previous setting, then we will transfer it to our setting and continue to record their learning on it.
