Dear Parents and Carers,

Residential Trip to Mill on the Brue

We are pleased to confirm that we have secured a booking for our Year 5 and 6 children (current Year 4 and 5) from both Burley and Sopley School to visit Mill on the Brue.

Dates:Monday 20 November to Friday 24th November 2023Venue:Mill on the Brue, Trendle Farm, Somerset, BA10 0BA (https://www.millonthebrue.co.uk/)

The cost of the accommodation and activities is £320.00 per child. The cost of the coach (both schools will travel together) to and from the venue is £1300.00 The total cost of the trip will vary depending on how many pupils go on the coach, but, as a guide, if all the children go on the residential, it will cost £345.00 per child.

Initially, we are requesting a £50.00 non-refundable deposit (payable via Scopay) to book your child's place – we need to receive this by Friday 21st October 2022. We appreciate that finances are stretched at this time and therefore we are suggesting that parents pay the remaining balance over 10 months. Once all deposits have been paid, we will know precisely how many children are going and can then confirm the balance.

We will be holding an information meeting to talk about Mill on the Brue on Monday 26th September at 3.30 p.m. and we encourage you to attend with your child so we can show you where the children will stay and what activities are on offer. Residential trips are a fantastic way of broadening your child's education and giving them a chance to learn and have fun away from home in a safe environment. This will be the fourth time that we have taken the children to this venue and each time they have had the most amazing experience.

Attached with this letter is a brochure which has further information on accommodation, food, activities and what a day might look like for the children.
