



Children's Internet Safety and Acceptable Use Agreement Key Stage 2

- These e-Safety Rules help to protect children and the school by describing acceptable and unacceptable computer use.
- I understand that the school owns the computer network and can set rules for its use.
- I know that ICT includes mobile phones, digital cameras, email, chat rooms and that this may also include personal ICT equipment, when used for learning.
- I understand that it is wrong to use a computer for a purpose not allowed by the school.
- I understand that if I knowingly break the rules for using the computers and internet, I may not be allowed some of my usual school privileges and my parents may need to know what I have done.
- I agree that when using the school computers I must use my user name and password, which must not be given to any other person.
- I understand that I must not install or run software brought from home on the computers or download from a website.
- I understand that all network and internet use must be appropriate to my learning.
- I agree that when researching material I must respect all copyright and should never try to pass work that I have copied and pasted directly, as my own.
- I understand that all messages shall be written carefully and politely and that unsigned messages and chain letters are not allowed.
- I understand that I must take care not to reveal personal information through email, personal publishing, blogs or messaging.
- I agree to use school managed blogs and discussion groups appropriately and politely.
- I agree that any inappropriate access to materials on the network or internet will be reported to a teacher.
- I understand that I must be socially responsible when using the internet and other communication technologies, including treating others with respect, and reporting online bullying. The school has the right to monitor the use of the school's computer systems, including access to web-sites, e-mail, blogs and chat-rooms and will withdraw these, and other privileges from individuals if inappropriate use takes place.



THE INTERNET

We have internet access on all computers in the school. It is filtered by Hampshire County Council via HSPN, a specialist internet filter.

Unsuitable sites are blocked and children **NEVER** access the internet without permission.

We use the Google search engine to search the web, which has a safe search feature permanently turned on. For more information please visit www.google.co.uk/safesearch_help.html.

While no system can be 100% effective, we think these safeguards mean that using the internet at school is as safe as we can make it.

We provide all children with a school email address. They will begin to use this in lessons during Key Stage 1. This is a safe and filtered email. This email address can be used at school and at home. All emails can be monitored by staff if a there is a concern.
