Dear Parents & Carers,

We are pleased to re-launch our Collins Big Cat eBooks. This scheme will be used alongside our Collins Big Cat Books (supporting Little Wandle Phonics) scheme. This will support the Little Wandle books we are sending home currently and in KS1 the e-copy sent home will be the book that the children are reading in their reading practice sessions in school. This will help with fluency and embedding key phonics skills.

The e-book library will enable children to access the reading books at their level in addition to the book they will bring home. This is not a replacement to their reading level book. It is also an alternative way to get your child into reading a wide range of books online.

How do I know what my child is reading in the e-book library is appropriate for my child?

Your child's class teacher will be in charge of selecting the books allocated to your child's e-book library. They may allocate one or more books at a time and will be able to see which of the books your child has chosen to read. We hope you enjoy accessing further books at home with your children.

Which books will my child bring home?

Your child will bring home a book linked to their phonics ability (decodable) and also have access to a library book, known as a 'sharing book,' which you can enjoy with your child at home. The e-learning copy will link to the reading practise book they are reading in class.

My child is in KS2 and needs further support with their reading, how will this help? Children in KS2 that are receiving catch- up phonics will have been selected for the e-library. KS2 catch- up books 7+ are perfect titles for children that may be reluctant readers, pitched at their levels but appropriate and engaging themes!
